

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



NOMINATING AND VOTING STAGES

What are some useful tips for completing the nomination form?

The judging panel will base their decision on the information in your nomination form, so ensure it's clear, concise and includes examples of how your nominee(s) has really made a difference.

We want to know:

- A bit about the person you're nominating – why do they support The Brain Tumour Charity? How do you know them?
- What have they achieved (relevant to the category) and how have they demonstrated an exceptional level of commitment to supporting the work of The Brain Tumour Charity? Give examples, i.e. how much have they raised and how (if nominating for The Viv McBeth Fundraiser of the Year Award)?
- Why you think they should receive special recognition in the form of an award, and what it would mean to them?
- What are their future plans for supporting the work of The Brain Tumour Charity?

Remember: your nomination doesn't have to be perfectly written. Our judges **won't be judging you on your spelling or grammar.**

What are the judges looking for?

In each category, the judges will be looking for positive and inspirational stories of achievement, commitment and dedication that align to the delivery of our strategy to double survival rates and halve the harm that brain tumours have on quality of life.

How do you select the winners?

All nominations will be considered by an internal panel who will agree a shortlist for each award category. Shortlisted nominations will then go forward to a final judging panel, each of whom are experts in their field or are passionate about helping us to defeat brain tumours sooner.

What are the next steps after nomination?

The panel will meet to decide the shortlist for each category in November 2019. Shortlisted individuals or teams will then be informed about the outcome and invited to attend the inspiring event in May 2020. Certain categories will then be opened up to our community for them to be able to vote for their winner.

ON THE NIGHT

Where is the event being held and what can I expect?

The event is being held in London in May 2020. It will start with a drinks reception followed by dinner and the awards ceremony.

Who can attend?

The judging panel will shortlist three nominations for each award and each of those will be allocated two spaces at the event.
