- to provide a clear role description and appropriate training for your role
- to provide regular support from your Volunteer Coordinator
- to give you the appropriate independence to make decisions
- to recognise your achievements, success and dedication
- to provide opportunities to develop your skills and experience
- to insure you against any injury you suffer or cause, as well as loss of property, whilst undertaking voluntary activities
- to reimburse out of pocket expenses in line with our current Volunteer Expenses Policy
- to resolve any problems or concerns you might have
- to provide a safe environment to volunteer in

As a volunteer, I will do my best:

- to understand and embody The Charity's values, representing us in a positive way
- to apply energy and dedication to my role, and be responsible for my own actions
- to give as much warning as possible when I am unable to volunteer so that alternative arrangements can be made
- to be aware of The Charity's work and keep up to date with charity news
- to follow the volunteer policies and procedures and seek guidance on anything I am unsure of
- to let The Charity know about any change of circumstances that may impact my volunteering

- to communicate clearly and frequently with my Volunteer Coordinator, completing reports and surveys as required
- not to behave in any way that could bring The Charity into disrepute, whether in person, in writing, or online. Volunteers are expected to act responsibly, respectfully, and in line with The Charity's values at all times
