

The Twilight Walk Own Walk FAQs

Date

Anytime in March

You can

- Pick your own distance
- Take on our traditional **5km** or **10km**
- Challenge yourself to walk **40km**, symbolising our shared goal of defeating the leading cause of cancer death in the under 40s
- or go all out with **130km** – one km for each of the 130 types of brain tumour that affect the community.

Own Walks

- Registration fee = Free
- Sponsorship Pledge is **£100** (per person)

Incentives

We're asking every walker to try to raise £100, or more if you can. This amount could buy 10 Information Packs for people newly diagnosed with a brain tumour, or 10 DNA preservation tubes for use in a cutting-edge clinical trial.

What's more, if you raise at least £100, we'll send you your very own commemorative Twilight Walk medal! The first 100 sign ups who also set up a Just Giving page and receive a donation will also receive a Twilight Walk Pin Badge (incentive launches when campaign launches).

If you set up a JustGiving page and raise over £300, you'll be entered into a prize draw to win a £50 M&S vouchers, there will be 4 separate winners (launches in January 2026 – 31st March 2026).

Who can take part?

The Twilight Walk is for everyone, of all ages and abilities. By holding your own walk, you can choose the distance and route that best suits you and your needs.

Is there a minimum age?

No, this Twilight Walk is open for everyone and there is no minimum or maximum age.

Do I have to raise a certain amount of money?

We ask that you try to raise a minimum sponsorship of £100 per person but there is no set amount you have to raise. By raising £100, we'll send you your very own commemorative Twilight Walk medal.

If you set up a JustGiving page and raise over £300, you'll be entered into a prize draw to win a £50 M&S vouchers, there will be 4 separate winners (launches in January 2026 - 31st March 2026).

Who needs to sign up?

For Twilight Own Walks, we only require the organiser of the walk to sign up (not all participants). We will then send the organiser information on how to let us know how many people are walking with you (if you are in a group) and how to order t-shirts for them as well if these are needed.

How do I fundraise?

When you sign up to organise your own walk, we'll send you an email with guide and information on the easiest way to fundraise for us. There is a walker's guide that will also give you top tips for maximising your fundraising and awareness. Only the walk organiser needs to sign up and all information will be sent to them,

Where should I send my sponsorship money?

What happens if I can no longer take part?

Do I get a t-shirt?

If you are the main contact and have opted to have a t-shirt when signing up to The Twilight Own Walk, this will be sent to you in the post. Extra T-shirts can be ordered any time before your walk, but please make sure you let us know at least 2 weeks prior to ensure they arrive with you in time. Extra T-Shirts can only be ordered through the main contact of the walk.

Do I get a medal?

If you are taking part in the Own Walk Twilight Walk, those that raise more than £100 will also receive a medal in the post. The first 100 sign ups who also set up a Just Giving page and receive a donation will also receive a Twilight Walk Pin Badge.
